

### PMKVY 2.0 – STT PROGRAM ANALYTICS: SECTORAL DISTRIBUTION OF TRAININGS ACROSS STATES



- The chart illustrates sectoral distribution of trainings under PMKVY 2.0 – STT (data as on 3rd Feb 2020) in Uttar Pradesh. This is part of an analysis done for top 10 states on candidate profiles and sectoral distribution of trainings.
- UP has the highest number of trained and placed candidates- 16.25% of total training and 15.59% of total placement.
- Electronics and Hardware alone accounts for close to one-fourth of trainings in the state, followed by Apparel, Retail and Logistics.
- Among the top 15 sectors, eight sectors (E&H, Apparel, Retail, Telecom, Construction, Green Jobs, Tourism & Hospitality and Power) have higher share among total placed than among total trained.
- Placement rate (placed/trained) in UP is 43.7%, nearly two percentage points lower than the all-India rate (45.6%).
- Among the top 15 sectors, six sectors (Apparel, Retail, Telecom, Green Jobs, Tourism and Hospitality and Power) have higher placement rate than the all-India rate.

## KEY HIGHLIGHTS

- 1 NSDC is collaborating with British Asian Trust to introduce a first-of-its-kind Skill India Impact Bond. The Skill Impact Bond is an innovative outcomes-based financing instrument which will catalyze the entry of impact investors and private sector outcome funders into the vocational training space.
- 2 NSDC organized a webinar on “Opportunities for Japan to work with high skilled IT professionals from India” to understand the demand for IT professionals in Japan and value proposition that India offers as a strategic partner. It was conducted in collaboration with Kawasaki NEDO Innovation Center from Japan and the speakers included experts from Japanese IT organizations.
- 3 NSDC and BetterPlace have collaborated for linking courses (both QP aligned and non QP aligned) on BetterPlace’s eLearning android application with eSkill India portal.
- 4 NSDC has partnered with IBM’s Open P-TECH platform to provide Indian youth access to digital learning in emerging technologies and workplace skills through eSkill India portal.
- 5 In partnership with Microsoft, NSDC co-hosted 9 webinars on various MS office products. 10,000+ participants have benefited through the webinars.
- 6 Webinars were conducted on ‘Enabling Trainers on Leveraging Digital Skilling Tools’ and ‘Digital Skilling and Learning Methods’ which were attended by 2,750+ participants.






