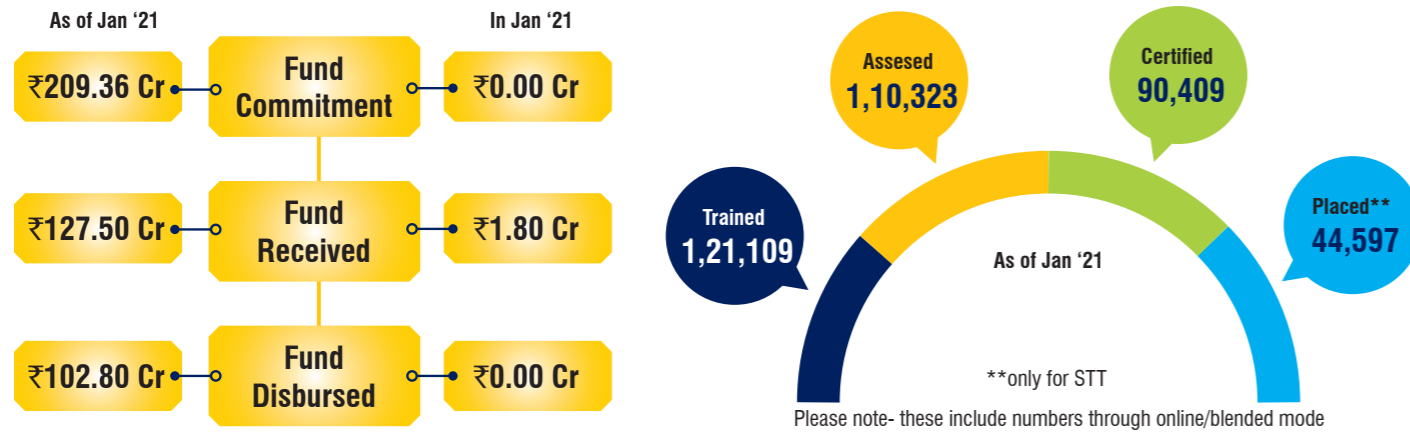
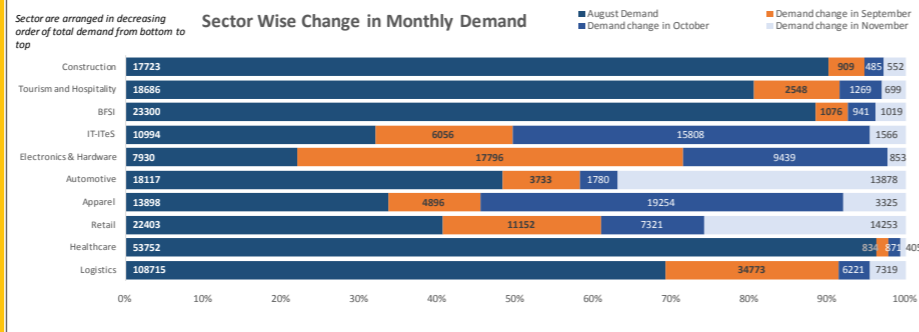

MARKET ANALYTICS

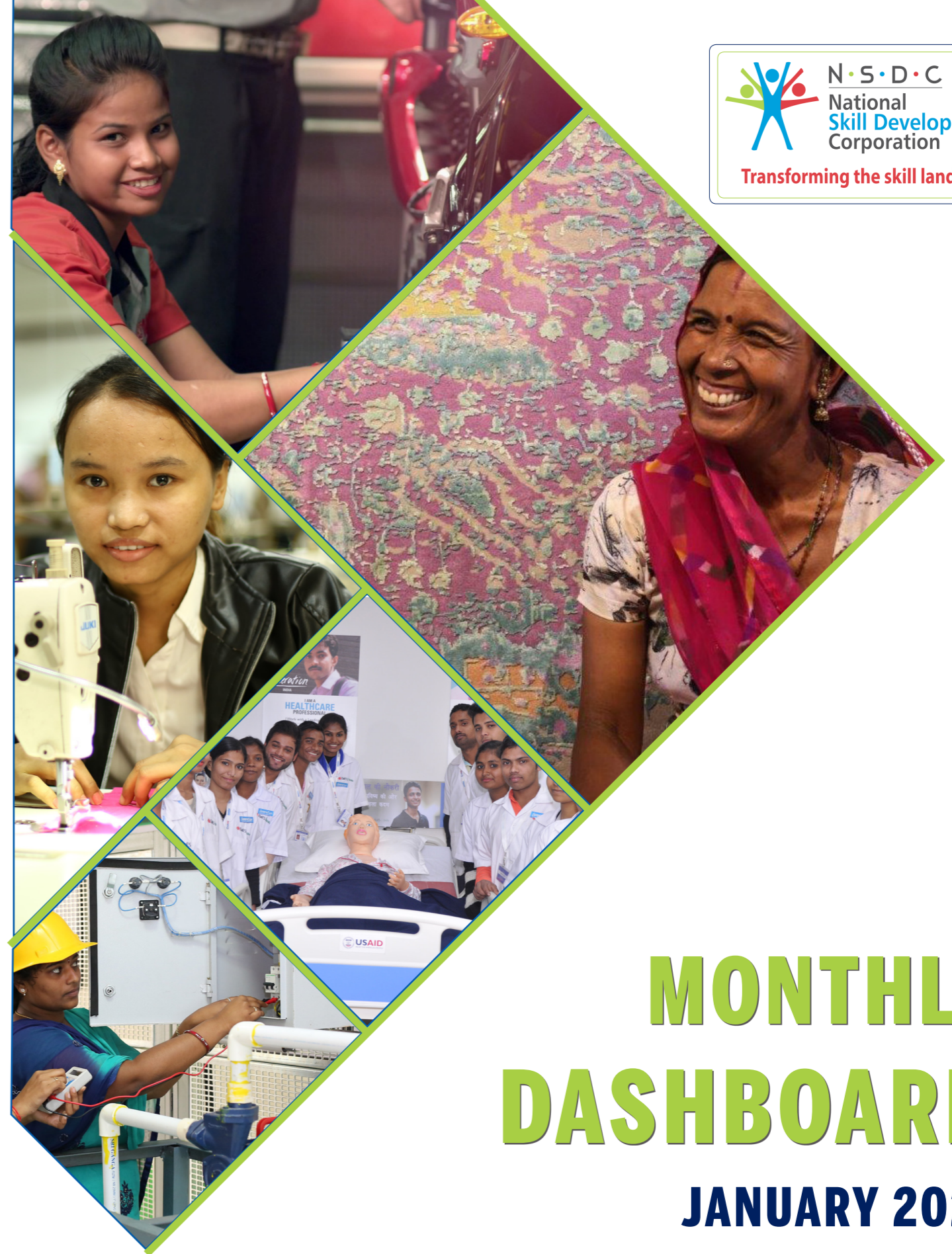
Data and objective of analysis: This analysis is based on cumulative monthly demand data through ASEEM portal for August to November 2020. The objective of the analysis is to assess the change in labour demand by State, Sector, Jobrole and district. The above chart is part of "ASEEM Demand analysis- November" and illustrates sector wise total labour demand in August and change (increase or decrease in demand) in September, October and November.



- ✓ Top 10 sectors which saw large addition to demand in November are Retail, Automotive, Logistics, Apparel and Telecom, IT-ITeS, Leather, BFSI, Textile and Handlooms and Electronics & Hardware.
- ✓ Retail (rank 4 in October => rank 1 in November), Automotive (8 => 2), Logistics (5 => 3), Telecom (9 => 5), Leather (36 => 7) and BFSI (11 => 8) moved up in rank in November while Apparel (1 => 4), IT-ITeS (2 => 6), Electronics & Hardware (3 => 10) and Textile and Handlooms (7 => 9) moved down in ranking.
- ✓ Emerging sectors (with minimal demand as of October but higher demand in November) are Aerospace and Aviation, Mining and Gem and Jewellery.

KEY HIGHLIGHTS

- 1 L&T Skill Trainers' Academy was inaugurated on 15th January 2021. The Academy is a world-class residential facility established to deliver high quality training of trainer and assessor programs for the continuous development of trainers and assessors in Short-Term Trainings.
- 2 Four International Assessment Centres have been empanelled in Mumbai, New Delhi, Cochin and Kolkata to deliver skill assessments in 5 benchmarked job roles under Kingdom of Saudi Arabia's Skills Verification Program.
- 3 NSDC partners with California State University Long Beach under a Knowledge Partnership to offer courses on eSkill India portal.
- 4 NSDC, in partnership with National Star College UK, and in association with FCDO-UK, has facilitated a series of eLearning modules on- 'Sensitization towards People with Disability'. One of the modules - 'Creating an Inclusive Environment' has been made available freely to all through eSkill India portal.
- 5 NSDC launched digital skilling for Powerlinks-CSR through a specially curated eCourse and navigation flow on eSkill India portal.
- 6 Over 500+ hours of content by IL&FS Skill Development Corporation have been made available on eSkill India in English, Hindi, Kannada, Tamil, and Telugu languages.
- 7 In collaboration with Construction SSC, two eCourses were released for free access via eSkill India portal.
- 8 Custom-curated eLearning program was released through eSkill India for 1 lakh Indian youth, in collaboration with American India Foundation.
- 9 Four free eCourses on Entrepreneurship released in collaboration with IIT-Bombay (E-Cell) on eSkill India.

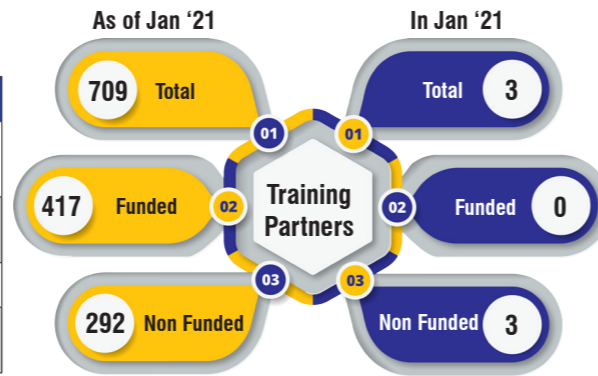

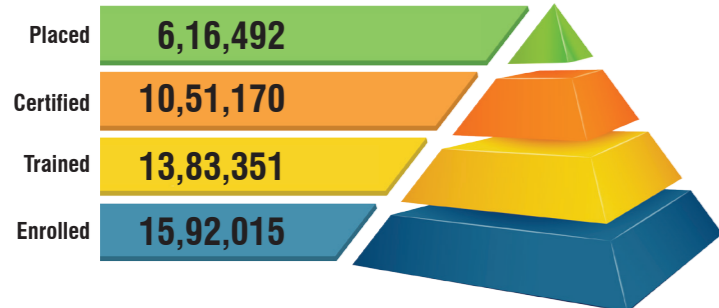

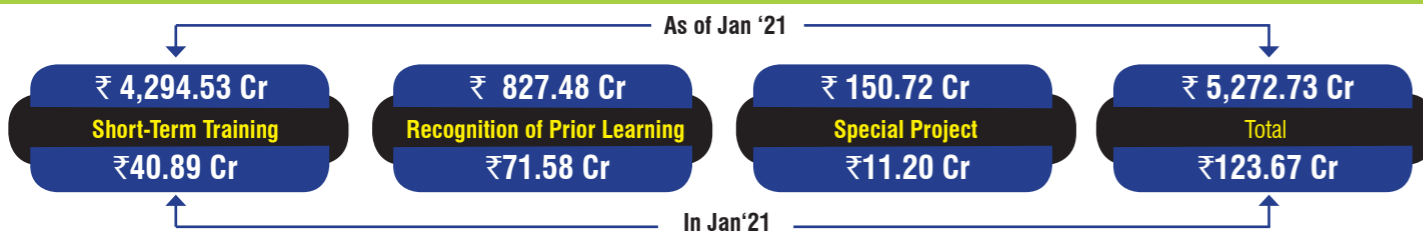

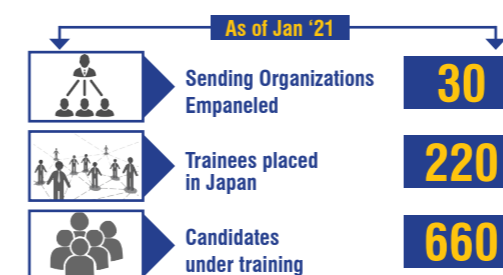
