


MARKET ANALYTICS

Data and Objective of analysis: Analysis is based on cumulative monthly demand data through ASEEM portal for August 2020 to March 2021. Objective of the analysis is to see the change in employer demand by State, Sector, Jobrole and district. The above chart is part of "ASEEM Demand analysis-March" and illustrates demand in top 10 sectors of march and their demand in previous months.

- **3X** increase in demand from Aug 2020 to March 2021
- Domestic workers, Tourism and Hospitality, Automotive, Apparel and Logistics saw large addition to demand in March over February.



**Top 10 sectors are as per March 2021, and sectors are arranged in decreasing order $\,$

- Two sectors Retail and Management observed lower cumulative demand in March 2021 compared to February 2021
- Domestic workers saw a significant increase in demand and moved to 9th rank in March from 24th rank in February. Domestic workers also was not among the top 20 sectors in January, but made its way in March by replacing Textile and Handlooms (which moved to 11th position in March 2021)


KEY HIGHLIGHTS

- 7. SahiPay nano-entrepreneurship opportunity extended to 11 training partners with 455 ongoing batches and 10,000+ students. 1,000+ candidates have enrolled for eSkill India-SahiPay course on Digital Financial Literacy and Creation of Nano-Entrepreneurs.
- 8. NSDC imparted digital skilling through eskill India portal on employability enhancer kit to 388 candidates under the CSR project with Powerlinks.




