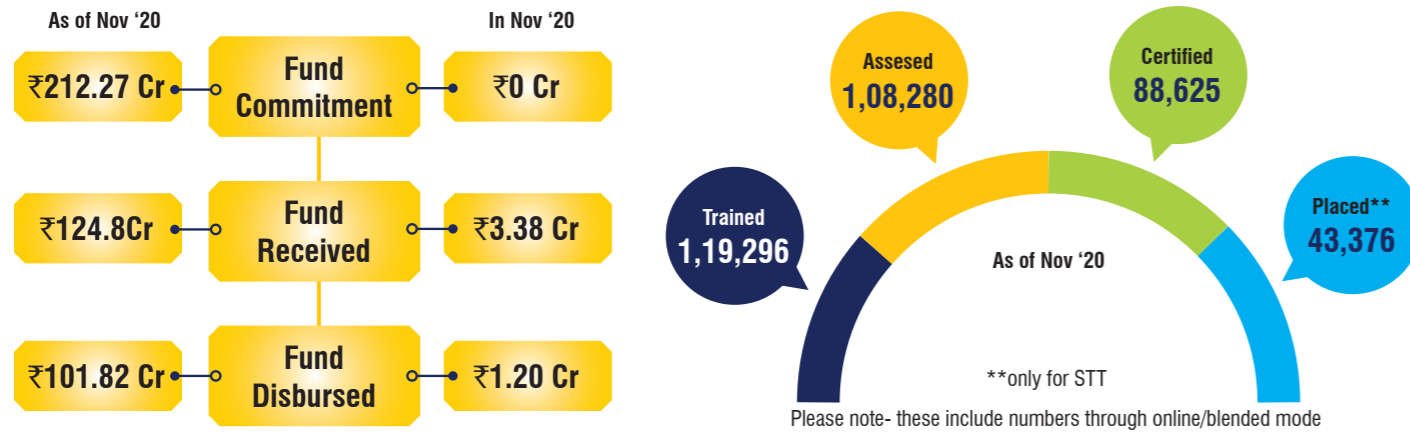

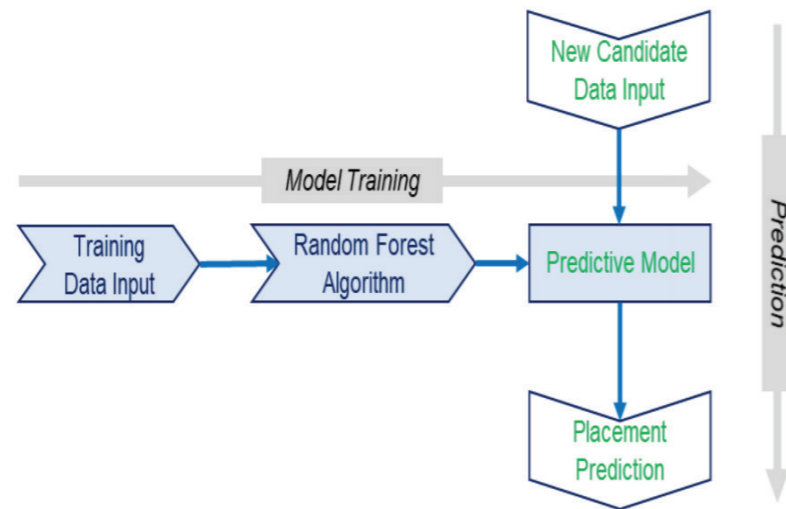
MARKET ANALYTICS

Study with Bennett University on usage of AI/ML for data-driven decision making in the skilling ecosystem

- ✓ Objective – identify factors that affect placements of candidates enrolled in PMKVY STT program
- ✓ Approach – Bennett University created a predictive model using Machine Learning (ML) on a random sample of 1,50,000 candidates enrolled in PMKVY STT program (See picture on the right)

Key findings :

- ✓ The model achieves close to 70 percent accuracy in the placement prediction
- ✓ The analysis revealed the importance of variables such as age group, name of particular training center (TC), training partner (TP) and job role details with regard to placements
- ✓ A subsequent suggestive modelling was also created to assist training centres and potential candidates on choosing best fit sector and job role in terms of post training placements

- 4 NSDC has partnered with Ybrant to catalogue their English and employability course on eSkill India portal.

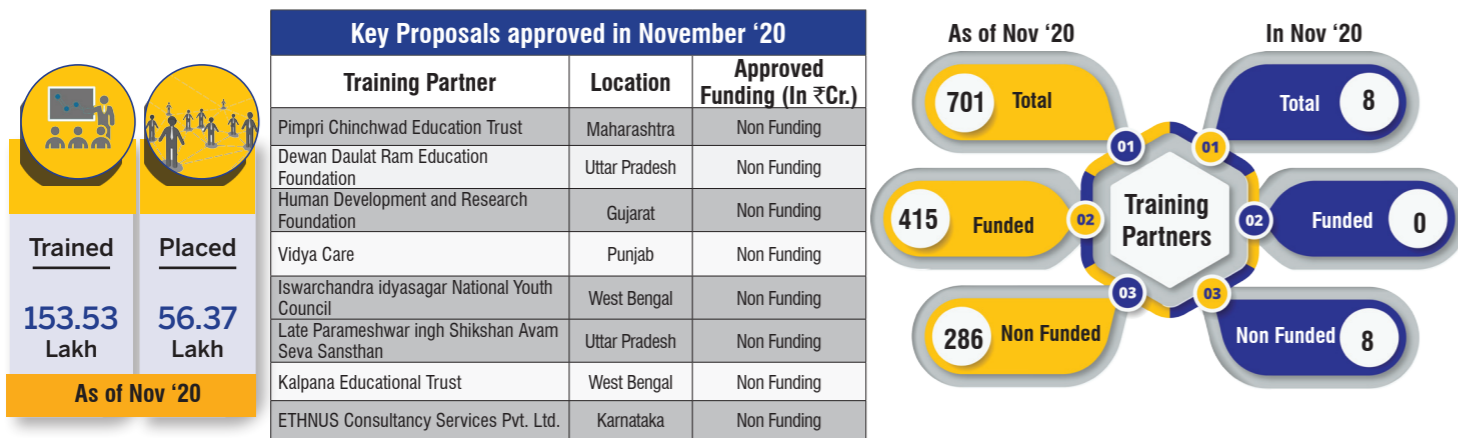

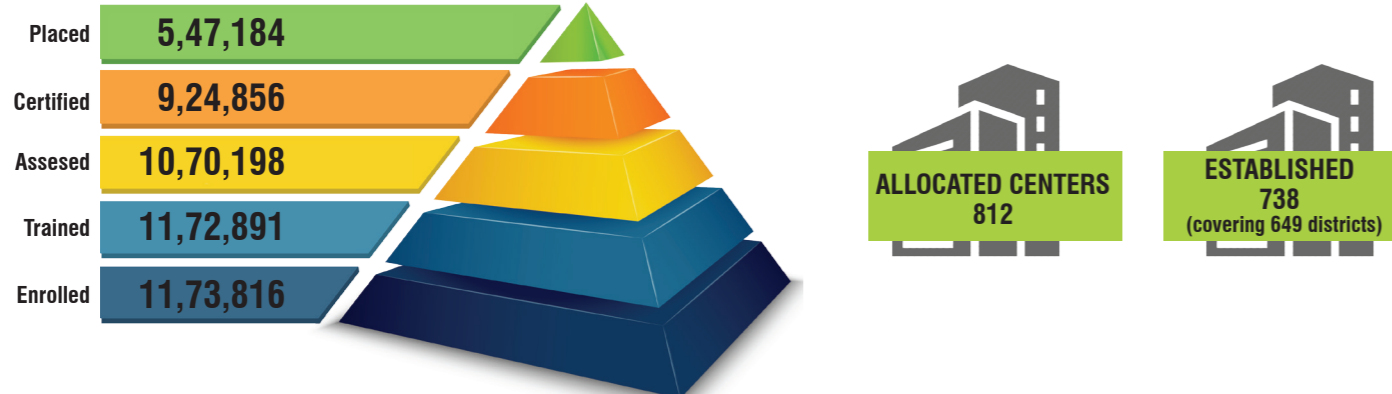

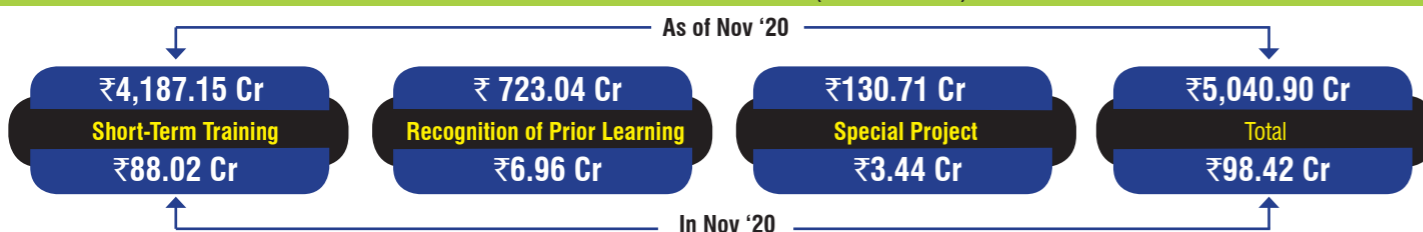
