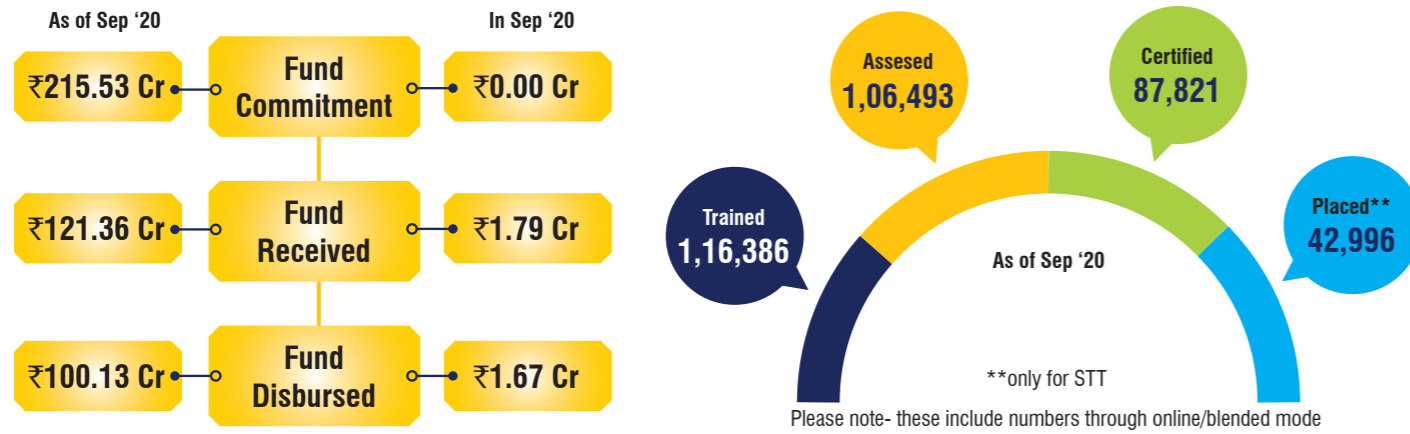
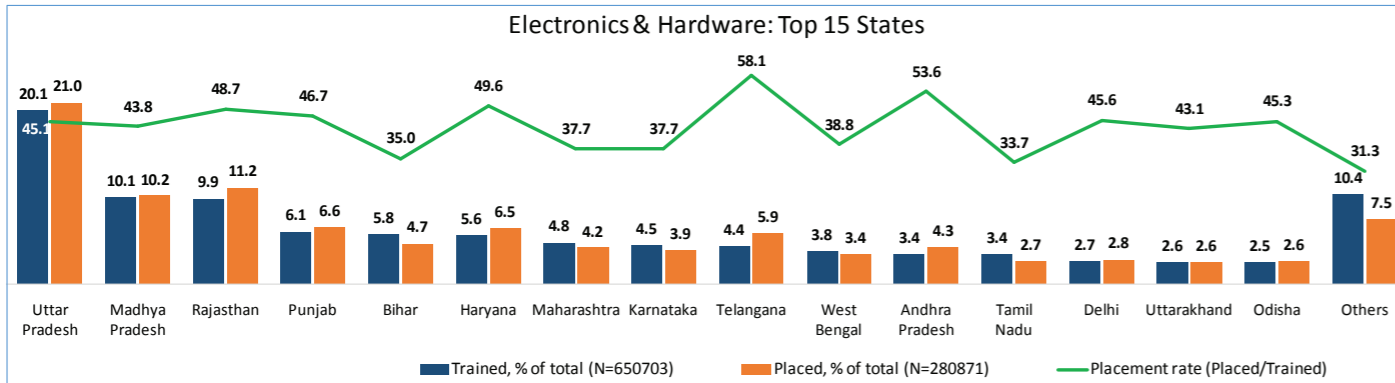

PMKVY 2.0 – STT PROGRAM ANALYTICS: STATE DISTRIBUTION OF TRAININGS IN ELECTRONICS & HARDWARE SECTOR



- ✓ The chart illustrates state wise distribution of trainings under PMKVY 2.0 – STT (data as on 3rd Feb 2020) pertaining to Electronics & Hardware (E&H) sector. This is part of an analysis done for top 10 sectors on candidate profiles and state distribution of trainings.
- ✓ E&H has the highest number of trained and placed candidates- 19.3% of total training and 18.3% of total placement.
- ✓ Uttar Pradesh alone accounts for close to one-fifth of trainings in the sector, followed by Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Punjab.
- ✓ Among the top 15 states, nine states (UP, MP, Rajasthan, Punjab, Haryana, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Delhi and Odisha) have higher share in total placed than in total trained.
- ✓ Placement rate (placed/trained) in E&H is 43.2%, more than two percentage points lower than the all-India rate (45.6%).
- ✓ Among the top 15 states, five states (Rajasthan, Punjab, Haryana, Telangana and Andhra Pradesh) have higher placement rate than the all-India rate.

KEY HIGHLIGHTS

- 15 SSC certified trainers and master trainers from short-term skill eco-system felicitated with National Awards for Excellence during Kaushal Acharya Awards 2020.
- NSDC has partnered with LinkedIn to provide Indian youth access to 10 LinkedIn Learning Paths. This consists of 140 courses on a range of in-demand tech jobs which will be made available for free on eSkill India platform.
- NSDC has partnered with TRUE-Test for offering free 'True Career Profiler Test' through eSkill India portal. This would enable Indian youth to discover their talent orientation and align that to appropriate skill development programs and relevant career opportunities.
- Online free course on Digital Super Star Trainer onboarded on eSkill India portal for up-skilling of trainers. Also, launched functionality for accommodating NRI/Foreign Nationals for undergoing training under Training of Trainers/Assessors on Skill India Portal (SIP).
- Online capacity building workshop on 'Developing Digital Content for VET in India' conducted to assist stakeholders engaged in the commissioning and creation of digital skilling content. This was attended by 400+ SSC staff, consultants and agencies working for the creation of content, subject matter experts, vocational trainers, instructional designers, trainers and training partners.
- A webinar was conducted for enrolled candidates on online learning through eSkill India portal and e-Book reader app.

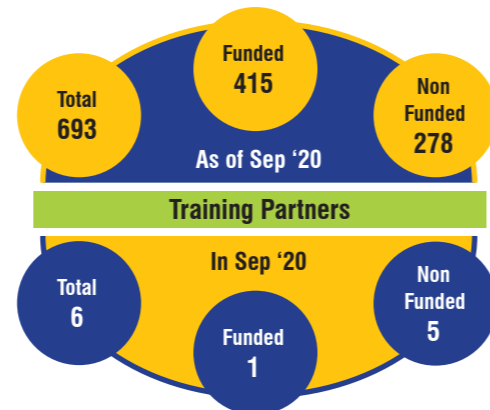

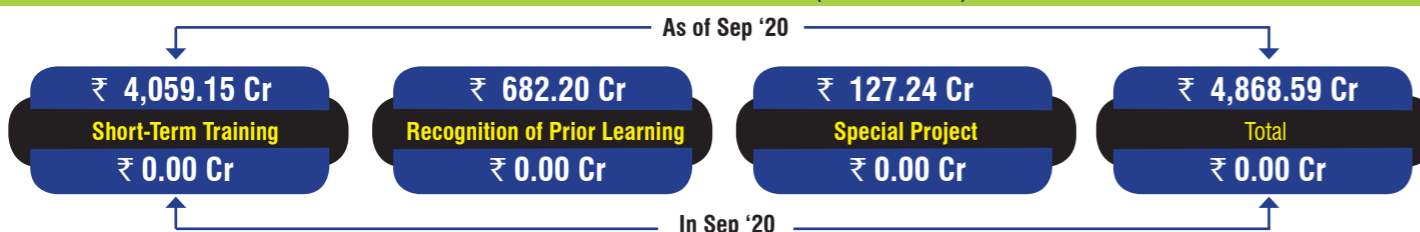
