

### MARKET ANALYTICS

Overview: Analysis is based on enrolled data (till December 2020) on e-skill India portal. Objective of the analysis is to see the distribution of enrolled candidates and course completion % by State, Sector, Jobrole etc. The chart shown here is part of "e skill India descriptive analytics" and illustrates state-wise enrollment and Average Course Completion (ACC) % of the candidates.

# Analysis of completed courses (Course status = course/assessment/certification complete)

- ACC % of the candidates is just 3.8%.
   Female candidates have slightly higher ACC % than male candidates (4.9% and 3.6%, respectively). Under 19 years age group (2.9%) has lowest ACC % however 40+ age group (5%) has highest ACC %.
- Among top five states, only UP and Bihar have lower ACC percentage than overall.
- Among top 20 states, 8 have higher ACC percentage than overall.
- Hindi courses have highest share in



enrollment (57.7%) however ACC % is just 3.5% (lower than overall ACC, 3.81%)

- Highest dropout (defined as candidates whose course completion % is 0%) is observed for male candidates (71.7%) followed by female candidates (69.2%) and transgender candidates (68.5%).
- Paid courses have 96.4% dropout and free courses have 69.5% dropouts.
- 14-18 years age group has highest dropout (75.3%) and 40+ has lowest (66%)
- Amrita Technologies alone accounts for 82% to total enrollments and has lowest dropout (67%)

Data: Online e-learning data for enrolled candidates, till 31st Dec 2020, has been analyzed. Data captures candidates' status on course like - course completion %, Assessment taken or not, Current status of the course, Certification status etc.

### **KEY HIGHLIGHTS**

- NSDC has partnered with Beumer India to offer them Skill Advisory
   Services for setting up a technical skill institute in Gurgaon. The institute will initiate skill development programs for technicians, suppliers and recently graduated students.
- NSDC conducted a Capacity Building Workshop with Singapore 6.
   Polytechnic and Temasek Foundation International from 22nd February 2nd March 2021 for Training of Master Trainers and Lead Assessors.
- 3. A virtual workshop was organized on 23rd Feb'21 with international placement agencies, chaired by Shri Praveen Kumar, Secretary MSDE. The objective was to understand specific country models, various challenges and required interventions. Over 20 IISC Network Members, engaged in International Workforce Mobility (IWM) attended the workshop. 6 organizations presented their respective cases on Europe, United Kingdom, Australia, Japan, Singapore, Gulf Cooperation Council.
- 4. NSDC organized a 2-part webinar series on 'Education Technology and Skill Development'. This brought together leaders from around the world who discussed their thoughts and learnings on the themes 'Emerging EdTech approaches around the world & learnings for skill development in India' and 'Readiness in India for adopting emerging digital approaches in skill development & way forward'.

- NSDC, in partnership with TrueTest, conducted a second counselling webinar on 'TrueTest- Discover your interest and personality orientation and become job ready'. This was attended by 220 + participants including SSCs, TP/TC SPOCs and users of eSkill India portal.
- 6. Coupon-based access to more than 120 candidates were provided under the operationalization of CSR project with Powerlinks.
- 7. NSDC launched eLearning modules on 'Sensitization towards People with Disability', made live in partnership with National Star College, UK, and in association with FCDO-UK. The initiative has received encouraging feedback from 40+ initial learners. More than 75% participants were able to accomplish all the objectives of the module.
- SahiPay nano entrepreneurship opportunity were extended to 11 Training Partners with 455 ongoing batches and 10k+ students. 850+ candidates have enrolled for eSkill India-SahiPay course on Digital Financial Literacy and Creation of Nano-Entrepreneurs.
- NSDC partnered with 1) HP (Hewlett Packard), 2) PMA India, 3) KnowledgeHut, 4) Speakin Communications Private Limited for providing online courses on eSkill India portal.






