Analysis on profile of Trainers based on data from Skill India Portal as on 31st March 2020





AN OVERVIEW



Key Highlights:

- 65% of certified trainers are concentrated in 10 sectors, with maximum number from Electronics, Apparel and Logistics
- 45% certified trainers are below 30 years indicating young professionals entering into the training space.
- 40% of certified trainers have completed their graduation and 5% of Trainers are flowing in from ITI/ Polytechnic.
- 70% of certified trainers have industry experience ranging from 0 5 years.
 - Average industry experience of certified Trainers across Sectors is 4.9 years and 3.08 years is the median value.
- 80% of certified trainers have training experience ranging from 0 − 5 years.
 - Average training experience of certified Trainers across Sectors is 3.84 years and 2.17 years is the median value.
- 34% of the total certified Trainers are females.
- 65% of certified trainers are concentrated in 10 states, with maximum number from UP, Maharashtra and MP. Overall, the North Zone has maximum coverage of certified Trainers.


Glossary:

- Certified Trainers: Data of Trainers who have been certified through ToT program and have certificates on SIP
- Active Trainers: Data of Trainers assigned to at least one batch out of 98,899 batches (may or may not be certified) includes both PMKVY (since January 2019 on SIP) and fee-based batches available on SIP

SECTOR-WISE TRAINER CERTIFICATIONS




- Electronics and Apparel together make up 25% of all Trainer Certifications.
- Sectors with higher activity of batches running under PMKVY and fee-based schemes have a higher count of trainer certifications.


AGE AND GENDER

- 34% women certified Trainers








GOEGRAPHICAL SPREAD

- Overall, the North Zone has maximum coverage of certified Trainers across zones



Sector-wise Industry Experience of Certified Trainers (in yrs)





- The Average Industry Experience of certified Trainers is 4.9 Years




• 70% of all Trainers are coming in with industry experience ranging from 0 – 5 years. 40% of all Trainers have 1-3 years of industry experience.

Sector-wise Training Experience of Certified Trainers (in yrs)





80% of all Trainers are coming in with training experience ranging from 0 – 5 years. 45% of all Trainers have 0-2 years of training experience.


CERTIFIED TRAINERS IN ACTIVE BATCHES



The following graph represents data of **98,899 QP-based batches** on Skill India Portal with **25,718 unique active trainers.**

- The count of Fee-Based batches is 27,795 with a trainer certification percentage of 17.9% (since February 2019)
- The count of PMKVY batches is 71,104 with a trainer certification percentage of 74.6% (since November 2019). Under PMKVY, the sub-schemes and certified trainer compliance rate are as follows:
 - **60%** of the batches are **RPL** with a compliance rate of **99.7%**
 - **39%** of the batches are **STT** with a compliance rate of **57%**
 - 1% of the batches are Special Projects with a compliance rate of 24%
