



## Objective

Study the number of youth expected to enter the labour force in India during 2018-19 to 2022-23

## Approach

Expected population and expected labour force participation rates are estimated for 5 years (from 'July 2018 – June 2019' to 'July 2022 – June 2023') to derive expected additions to the labour force

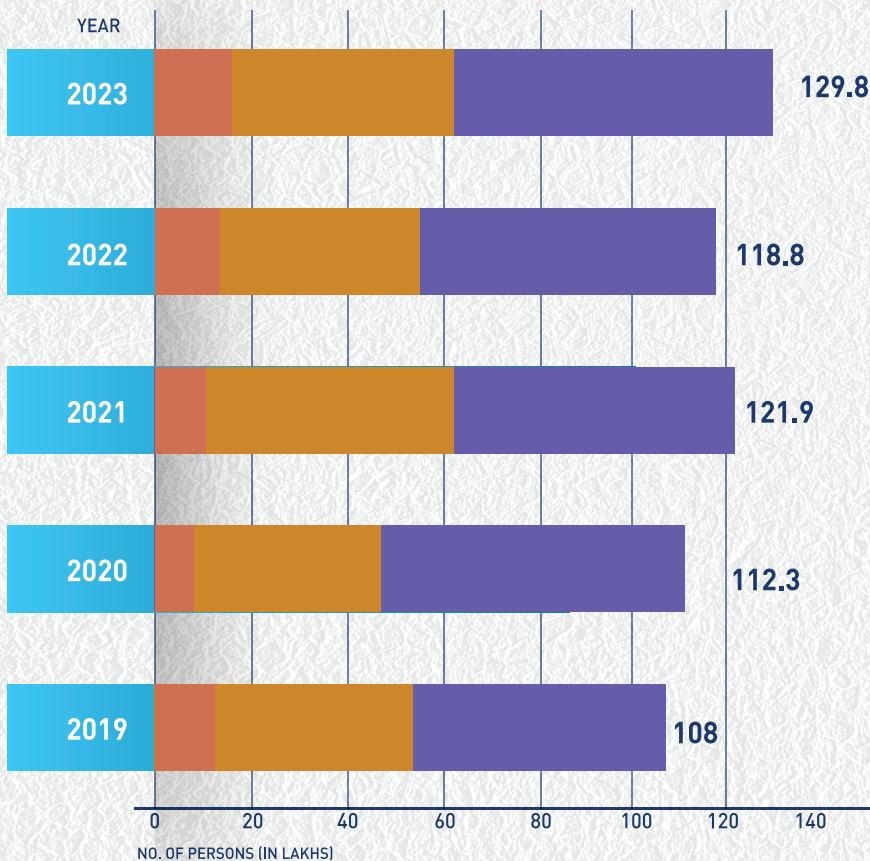
## Data Source Used

- Crude Death Rates (CDR) at gender and region (rural/urban) level estimated by Central Statistics Office (CSO)
- Employment-Unemployment Survey (EUS), 2011-12 (NSS 68th round)
- Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS), 2017-18

# Youth Expected to Enter The Labour Force

## About 5.9 crore youth (aged 15-30 years) are expected to enter the labour force in India by the year 2023

Total No. of Youth Entrants - 590.7 Lakh

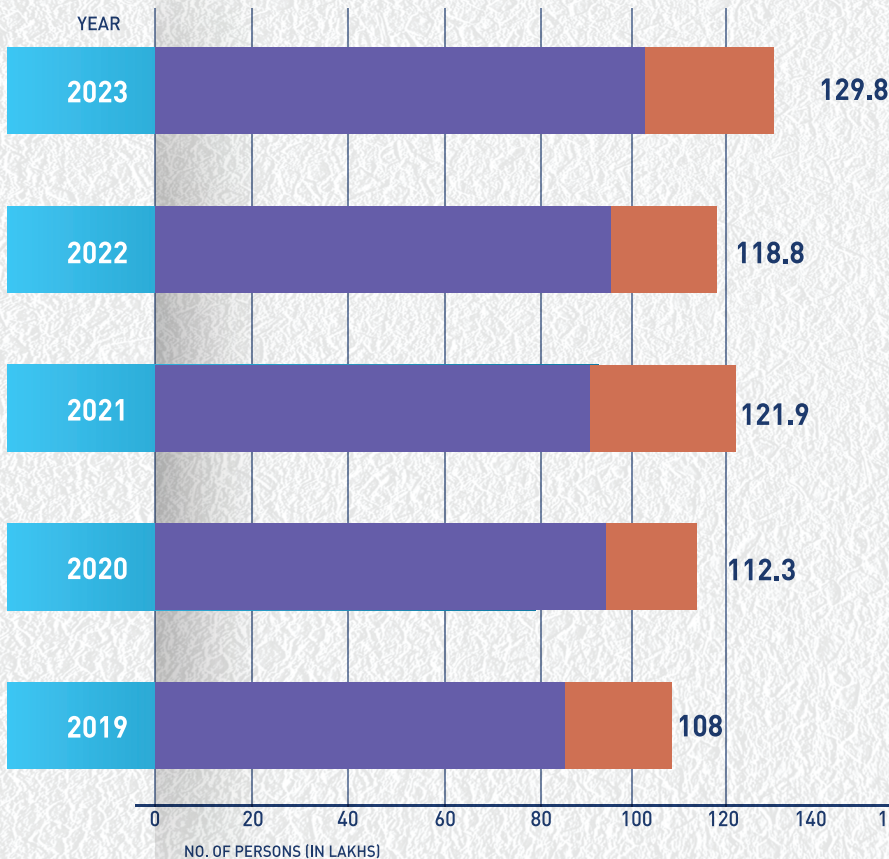


- A total of 7 crore additional number of individuals in the working-age (15-59 years) are expected to enter the labour force in India by the year 2023, out of which 5.9 crore belong to the age group 15-30 years
- 50% of the youth entrants belong to the age group 15-20 years
- The number of expected entrants peaks in the year 2023

# Gender-Wise Breakup

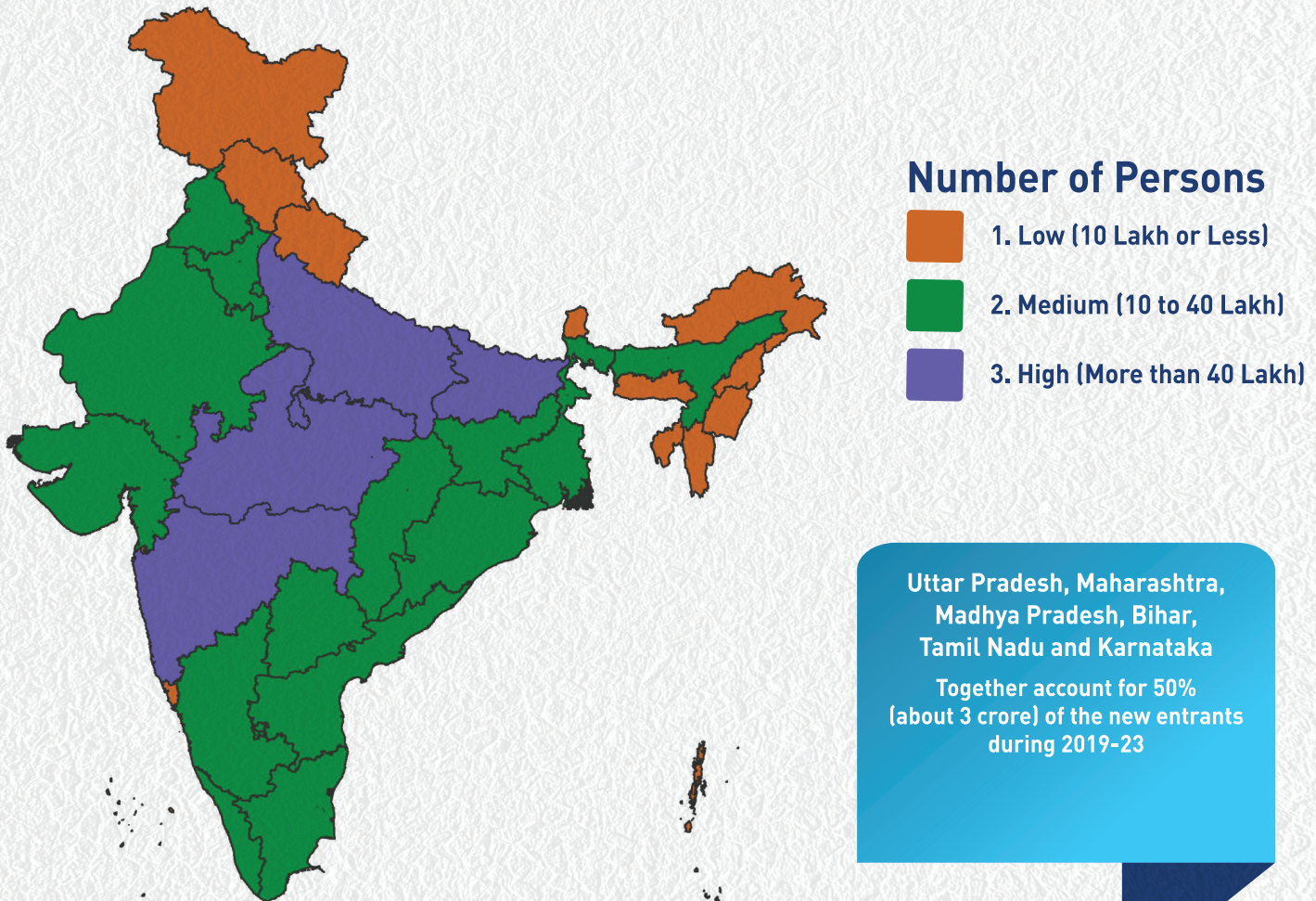
## Only 1 out of 5 youth who are expected to enter the labour force are women

Total No. of Youth Entrants-590.7 Lakh  
Male-471.9 Lakh, Female-118.8 Lakh



- 52% of the male youth entrants and 42.6% of the female youth entrants belong to the age group 15-20 years
- Among female youth, the highest number of new entrants (29 lakh) are expected to be witnessed in the years 2021 and 2023.
- While among male youth, the highest number of new entrants (1 crore) is expected to be witnessed in the year 2023.

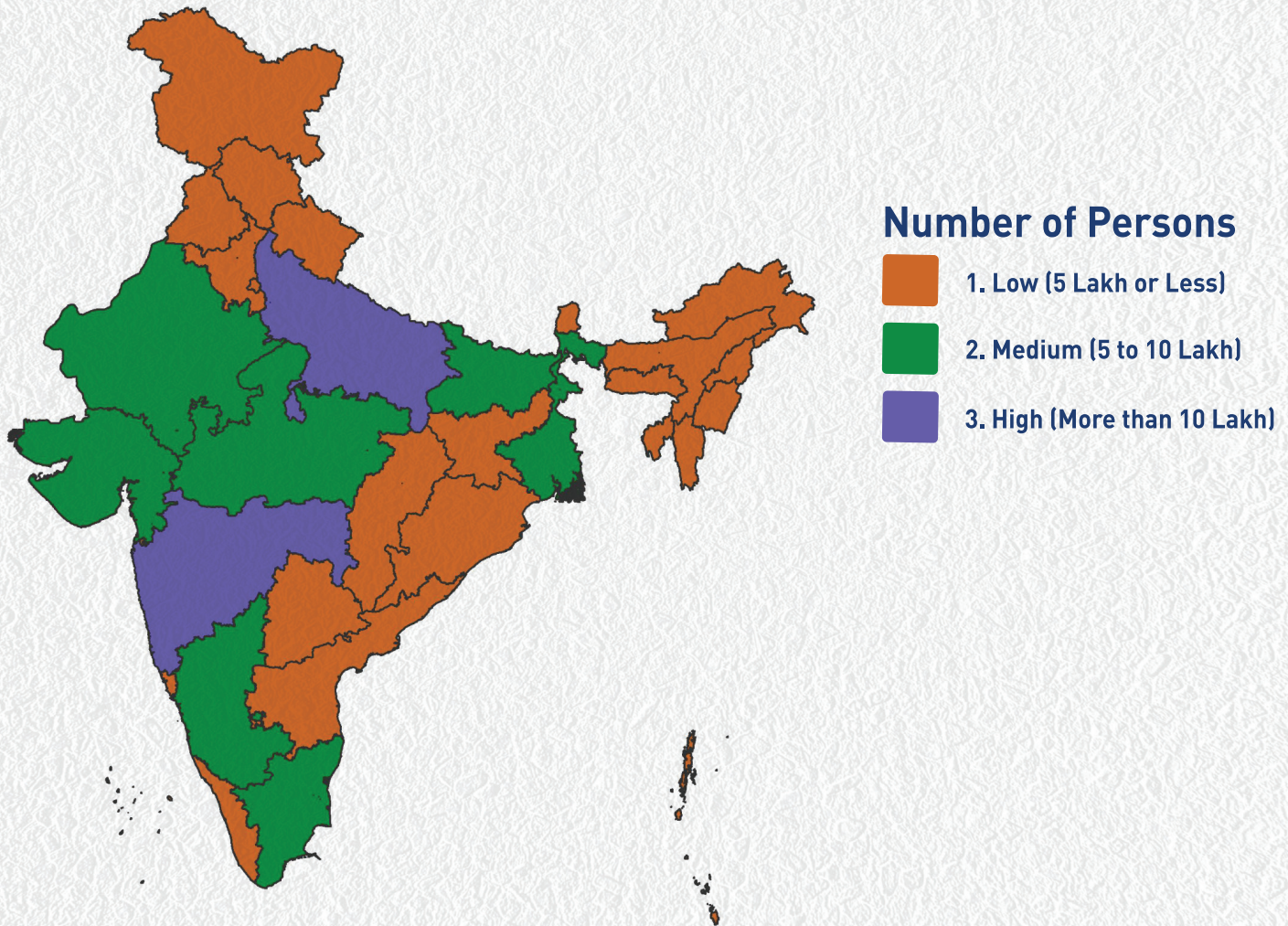

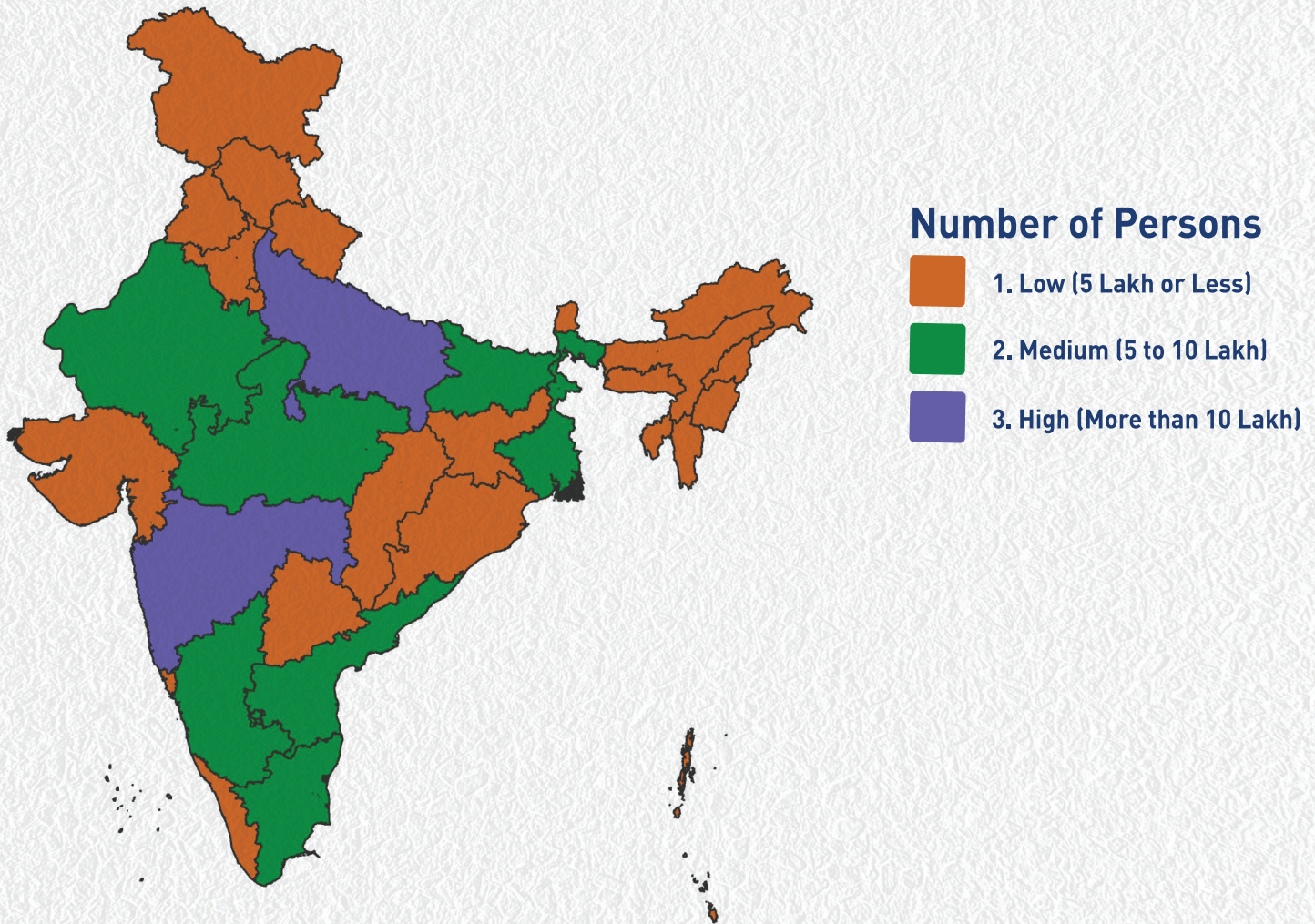

## Youth (aged 15-30 years) expected to enter the labour force in the year 2020

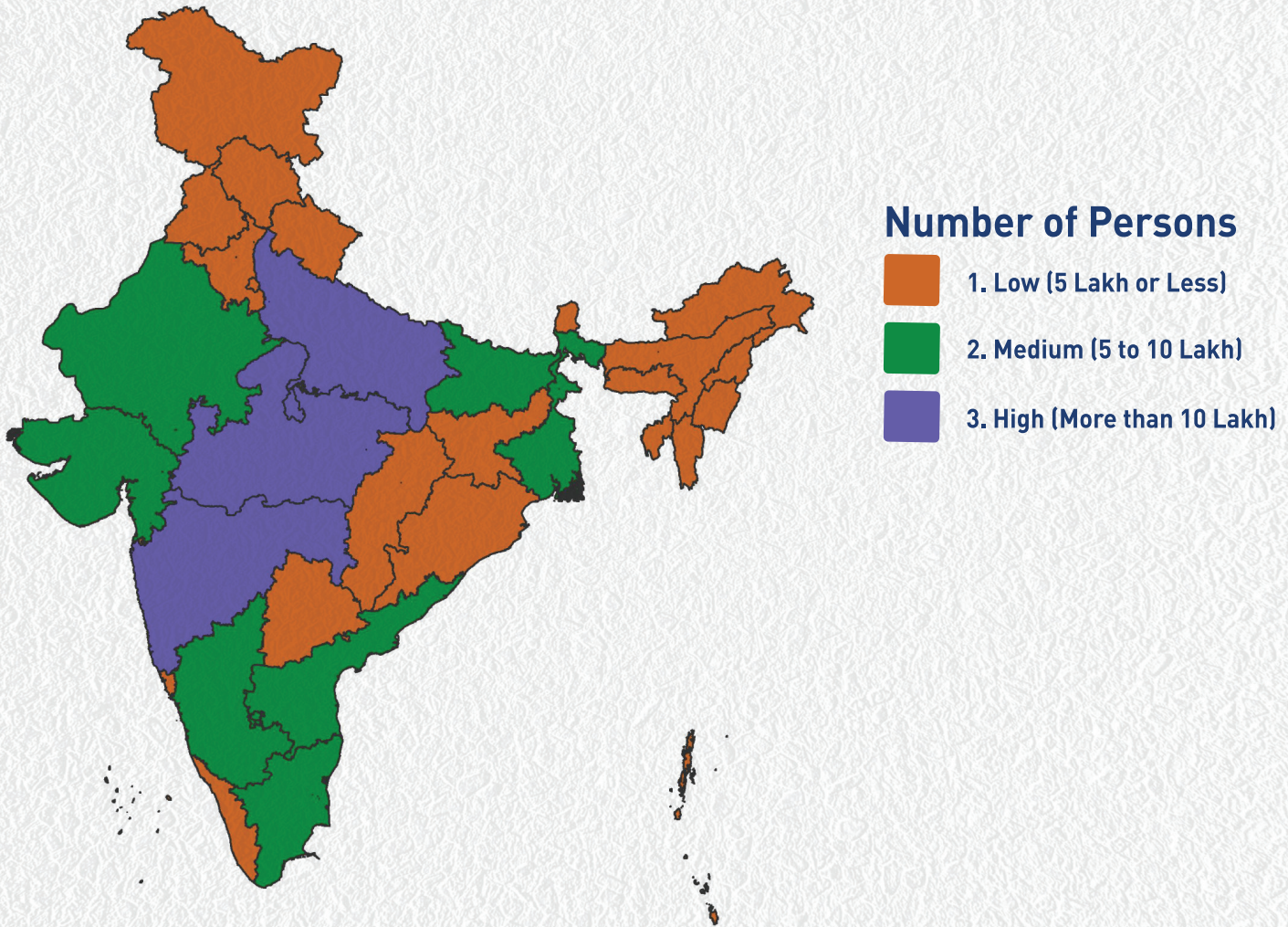

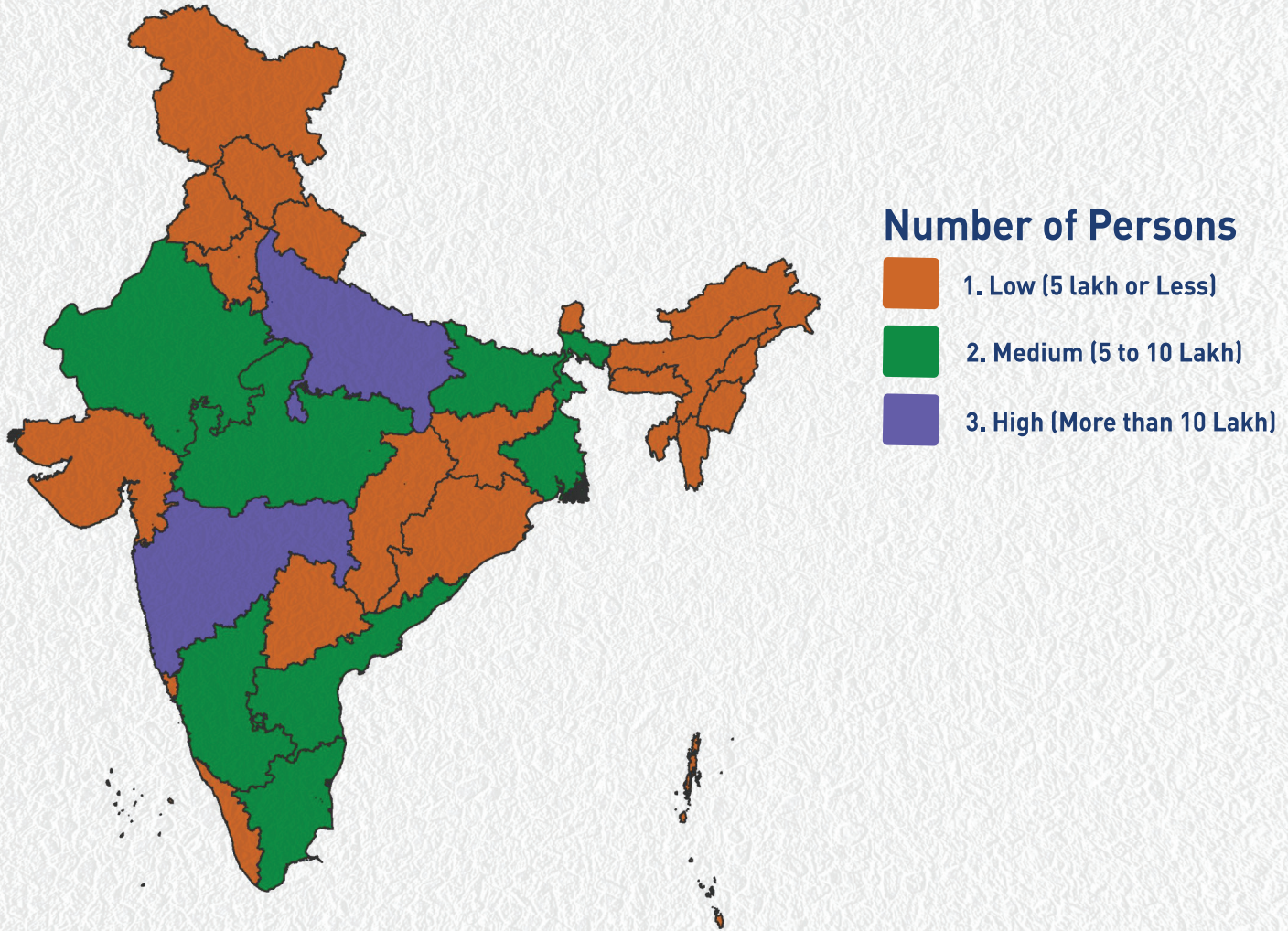
## Youth (aged 15-30 years) expected to enter the labour force in the year 2021

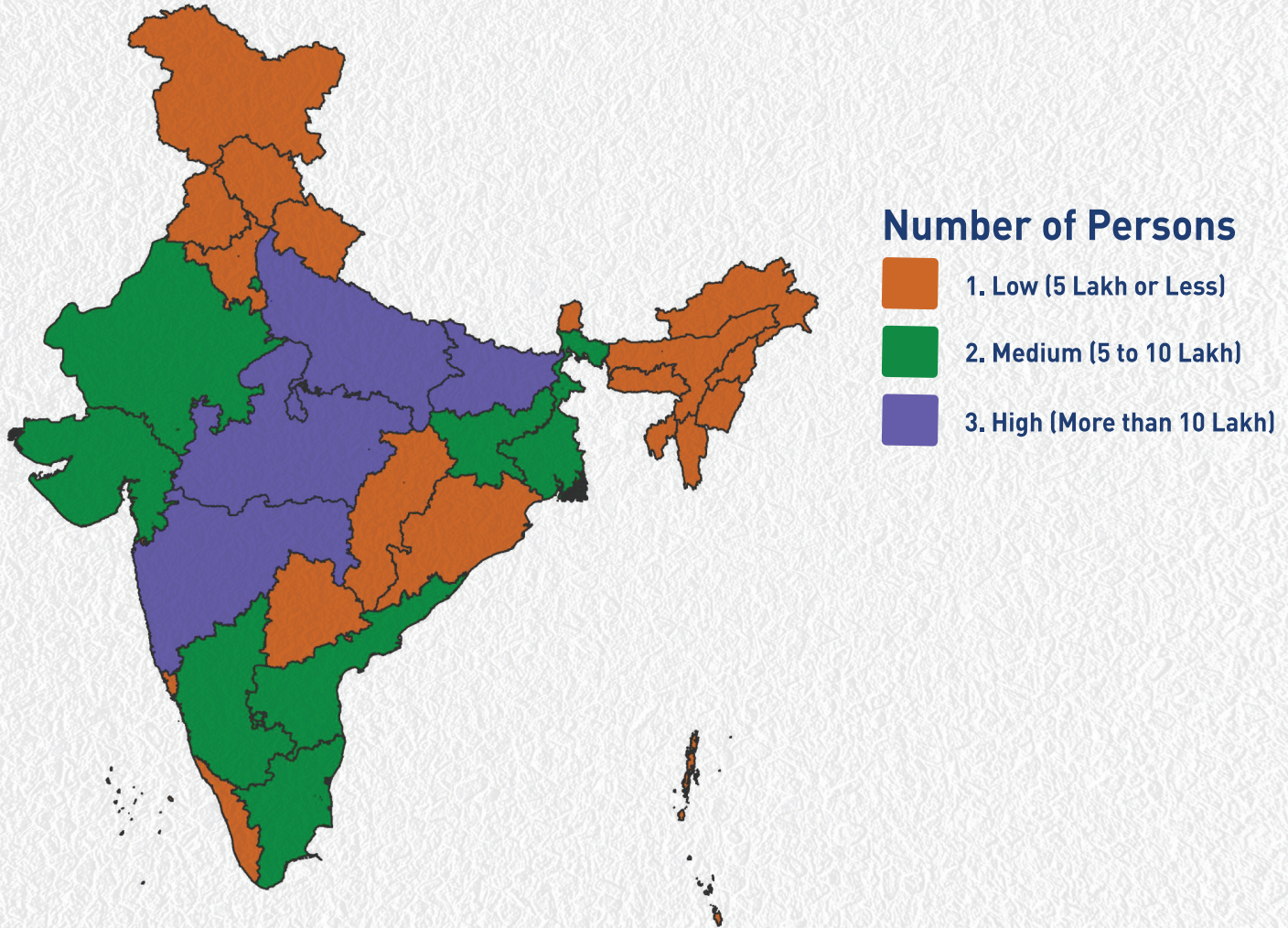
## Youth (aged 15-30 years) expected to enter the labour force in the year 2022
